Level	What this includes	Price
1	<u>Screening for learning disability.</u> This battery is a brief screening assessment designed to determine if a person has a learning disability in the shortest amount of time for those over 16 yrs of age. If the WAIS III or IV is required, Level 1 is not the assessment to do. Testing is done by a graduate student or a recent Ph.D.	\$700
2	<u>Full 8 hours of Testing, 2 page report.</u> This includes the Wechsler Intelligence Scale, most of the Woodcock-Johnson Cognitive and Achievement Batteries, plus at least one timed reading test. Medical/developmental history and symptom reporting are not included. Testing is done by a graduate student or a recent Ph.D.	\$1,200
3	<u>Full 8 hours of Testing, Detailed Report.</u> This includes Level 2 plus a long report, detailing the tests, medical and developmental history and symptom reporting. This evaluation will satisfy most colleges and some testing organizations. Testing is done by a graduate student or a recent Ph.D.	\$1,700
4	<u>Full 8 hours of Testing, Detailed Report, done by senior licensed staff.</u> This includes the 8 hours of testing in Level 3 and a detailed report, but a senior licensed staff person does the testing.	\$2,500 (est.)
5	<u>Full 8 hours of Testing, Detailed Report, done by Dr. Thomas and senior licensed staff.</u> This includes the 8 hours of testing in Level 3 and a detailed report.	\$3,400 (est.)

ADD Evaluations		
Level	What this includes	Price
1	<u>Brief ADD Evaluation.</u> This is a special research project assessment for ADD teens and adults, and is a 4 1/2 hour testing battery. This screens for overall intelligence, attention and concentration measures, verbal and visual memory, reading speed and comprehension, and includes a personality assessment. These are done on Saturdays from 10am-3pm, with the testing is done by a graduate student or a recent Ph.D.	\$700
2	<u>Full ADD Evaluation with 2 page report.</u> This includes a full intelligence battery in addition to the above, a continuous performance and an attention battery.	\$1,200
3	<u>Full ADD Evaluation with Full Report.</u> This is Level 2, with 8 hours of face-to-face testing, plus a personality assessment, and a detailed report. This evaluation will satisfy most colleges and some testing organizations. Testing will be done by a graduate student or a recent Ph.D.	\$1,700

<u>QEEG Evaluation</u> A Quantitative Electroencephalogram (QEEG) is recommended for those who are planning to do EEG Biofeedback. This assessment measures the different brain waves (delta, theta, alpha and beta) at 19 sites and the relationships of all pairs of sites in several parameters, such as coherence, phase, and asymmetry. It is also recommended for those who want to know precisely how the person's brain functions, as well as for more precise medication recommendations. Currently we are not doing QEEG evaluations.		\$800
<u>EEG Biofeedback</u> Also called neurofeedback, this is a new treatment modality that has been shown to be effective in treating Attention Deficit Disorder, stroke, headaches, mild head injury, migraines, chronic pain, and other neurological and immunological conditions. One should plan to do two sessions per week, for about 20-40 sessions, over a continuous period if possible. Insurance (which covers biofeedback) may reimburse you for treatment for some medical conditions (e.g. panic attacks, migraines, seizures). A MD Rx for Biofeedback, CPT 90901, is necessary for insurance coverage.		\$175-225/ session
<u>Cognitive Remediation</u> Consists of structured exercises designed to improve weak cognitive abilities. The treatment is customized to the client's needs as delineated by the finding from the neuropsychological evaluation and the client's specific concerns.		\$175-225/ session
<u>Psychotherapy</u> For ADD, learning disabilities, mild head injuries, or other neurological disorders. Dr. Thomas or a senior licensed staff member is available for individual psychotherapy sessions during weekdays for these or any other psychological conditions.		\$175-225/ session
